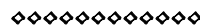


... WITH A PASSION FOR FEEDING THE HUNGRY

Funds from his tours are used to sponsor scholarships for Tarahumara youth for whom he is a role model and mentor. Mr. Wheeler's touring has two main objectives: First, to bring the peace and tranquility of the Tarahumara Mountains through his compositions and interpretations of the classics. Second, and most importantly, Mr. Wheeler wishes to raise awareness of the plight of one of the most unique indigenous tribes in Latin America, the Tarahumara Indians, and hopefully to raise funds to cover the required tuition fees and expenses to enable young Tarahumara natives to study beyond primary school and achieve a higher level of understanding of the world they live in, thereby learning how to cope with the realities of the 21st century. www.romaynewheeler.org
