**Famine threatens** 20 million along Horn of Africa: The hunger crisis in the Horn of Africa countries is so severe that famine now threatens 20 million people, the UN's World Food Programme warned Tuesday. "These people have run out of food and water," WFP head James Morris said of northeastern Kenya, one of the areas hit hard by drought, and urged donor countries to help more. "Unless we reach them all very soon we will run out of time."

**A time for harvest:** In 2000, Rotarians from Rotary Club Olsztyn, Poland and US District 5730 partnered on a Rotary matching grant for the benefit the Dom Dziecka Orphanage in Morag, Poland. About 2,500 fruit trees were planted and now the harvest is plentiful. So plentiful, in fact that a storage facility is needed to keep the fruit over the winter months. A building located near the orchard has been located to serve as a fruit store, which will directly benefit the orphanage, and will also supply fruit to similar institutions (including those for the elderly) in the surrounding area.
