To Feed The Hungry and Help Them Become Self-Reliant

WHERE DOES YOUR DONATION GO....

In the past **4 months**, Hunger Plus has donated **\$700,000** of food and humanitarian

supplies to the impoverished people in the USA, Mexico & Honduras.

The following supplies were distributed among the people in all three countries:

WATER

Thousands of vitamin-enriched water bottles were given to families in need due to lack of clean water or because of the great distance they have to travel to get water.

FOOD

All types & varieties were given to orphanages, Missions, churches, food banks and shelters to feed the starving families and children.

MEDICAL & DENTAL EQUIPMENT

Including exam tables, fracture tables, dental chairs, medical tools, sterilizers, medical clothing, IV poles,



medicines, wheelchairs, prep supplies, and much, much more we provided to the people of Honduras to form medical & dental clinics where the needs are greatest.

INFANT/BABY CLOTHING & SUPPLIES

Proper care for infants is a huge burden for poverty stricken people; so we've helped by supplying formula, clothing, blankets, monitors, insulators, etc..

BASIC NEEDS

Toothpaste, blankets, cleaning supplies, etc. These are luxury items to the people we help.

SHIPPING

To get the food & supplies to the locations we help; the items need to be delivered by ship, truck, pick-up, etc. Due to the size of the loads we send— this is costly. Some of our costs are donated, but not all—so the fees can amount to thousands of dollars per load.

IMAGINE....

Close your eyes.... now just for one moment think about being without your basic needs.

Imagine that you have no water—what kind of impact would that have on your family? Think of being without food—and not knowing **when** or **if** you would eat again. You have no television, no cell phone, no computer, or a home with 4 walls and a roof to protect you from the elements.

How would that alter your life? Change your priorities?

Now think of being pregnant—no squeaky clean, fully furnished medical facility; no prenatal vitamins; no ultrasound or neonatal specialist.

Or imagine having a sick child—and no medicine or facility to treat them.

What if malnutrition was weakening your teeth, causing cavities, gum

erosion, mouth sores and cankers; and there was no dental facility or dentist.

Think of that way of life for just a moment.

For most of us, the thought is fleeting—hard to imagine, really, because that way of life doesn't exist for us. But it does exist. For too many people that is their way of life everyday; yes, even in America.

These are the types of situations that the people we help live in on a daily basis. We can't imagine doing it for a moment, much less for our whole life. How precious a donation of even 1 meal a day would be to you, how you would savor that first taste of clean water. The relief of knowing a doctor had medicine for your sick child or that you could hope your child would be born healthy.
