He has been involved with Hunger Plus for many, many years and provides all of the financial documents necessary to retain our 501 c 3 status. Phelps has a passion for growing food and providing nourishment to those that go hungry. He is a married father and grandfather.

UPDATES.....

During the last several months, Hunger Plus, Inc. and many of our partner agencies have been inundated with help requests. The weather, politics and economy have all played a part in causing great need in the already destitute areas of the world.

Here are some updates as to what we have accomplished with our partners in recent months:

Pakistan - due to the flooding and monsoons that occurred starting in July 2010, more than 14 million people were affected. Hunger Plus worked with our partners to send them several full containers of medical equipment and supplies valued at over \$1 million.

Nicaragua - We have partnered with Mission Para Cristo to help this area of the world that not only was hard hit by flooding, as well, but then were also displaced by Hurricane Mathew. We sent them a full container of food this week and are in the process of coordinating a shipment of 43,000 lbs of beans to help supplement their food supplies.

Honduras - Honduras continues to be a country where over 75% of their population lives in poverty. We continue to help in the orphanages, hospital, Missions and dump sites. We have sent: food, medical supplies & equipment. Optical equipment, shoes, an ambulance, clothing and other humanitarian aid. The value of these combined loads is well into the millions of dollars. We also recently completed Million Meals Honduras Project where Rotarians joined together to provide over 3 million meals to these desperate people. Currently, we are working on a project to sent 43,000 lbs of beans to these folks.

USA—Pennsylvania - We have partnered with the District 7350 Rotary Club to provide food to a portion of PA that is desperately in need of food. HPI has sent to date three loads of food valued at over \$500,000.00. This is going to be an on-going project; we will continue to provide updates as they become available.

USA—Texas—Partnering with the Salvation Army, we were able to secure a large bus for them to use to transport children, people without a car to places they need to go—church, school, doctor visits, etc. We also have given the Salvation Army food, clothing and other humanitarian aid to help the needy. Near the Mexico borders, including El Paso—we have provided food, clothing, over the counter medications, shoes and other humanitarian aid for these people hit hard by politics and drug wars. Ted Baker and his staff at Wal-Mart Distribution partnered with us on several loads to this area. We also have provided food, books, clothing, hygiene products and medications to our local food banks, child centers, senior centers, crisis centers, missions and churches.

Mexico - Many of the people living along the US borders are plagued by poverty. Guns, drugs and government issues have reduced their ability to survive to an all time low. We are providing them with food, medical supplies, hand tools for farming and an ambulance.
